Mobile Crisis Intervention (MCI) will connect individuals to the services they need, which may include inpatient psychiatric treatment, 24-hour diversionary levels of care, urgent mental health or addiction counseling or psychopharmacology, or connections for follow-up appointments.



They used to be called **Emergency Services Providers (ESP).**

Now, they're enhanced services called **Mobile Crisis Intervention (MCI).**
